

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA FOR DRUG TREATMENT COURT

Screening for entrance into the program will be available to those defendants who: are detained at the Lancaster County Prison; currently on pre-trial supervision; currently on probation supervision, and/or are awaiting preliminary hearing before a Magisterial District Justice for an eligible criminal offense. The following criteria have been established to identify persons who may qualify for admission to the Lancaster County Court of Common Pleas Adult Drug Court:

- Offender has a verifiable history of substance abuse
- Offender is a Lancaster County resident, age 18 years or older
- Offender commits an offense related to substance abuse (not necessarily a drug offense)
- Offender voluntarily agrees to participate in, and be subject to rules, regulations and sanctions of Drug Court
- Tech PV's are eligible as long as the above criteria apply (the underlying charges are not limited to the list below)

The following is a list of criminal offenses where offenders may be eligible to participate in the Drug Court Program.
